

East London's brightest new community



The Furniture Practice's Build to Rent team was appointed to support the design development and manage the furniture specification, procurement, delivery and installation for the expansive Coppermaker Square project, which encompassed a total of 600 apartments and extensive amenity spaces. With a steadfast commitment to crafting a seamless urban living experience for residents, the diverse array of amenity spaces includes a spa, pool, lounge, meeting rooms, coworking spaces, private dining areas, games room, and a screen room lounge.

Delivering comfort, luxury, and practicality


